WHAT IS THE LIFE NEEDS ASSESSMENT?

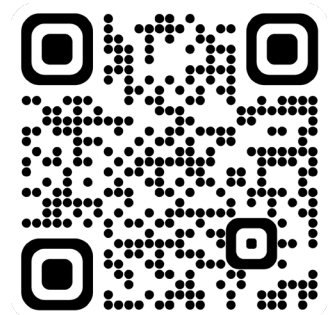
The Life Needs Assessment is a shared data network resource that was originally designed for nonprofit organizations in Onondaga County and is now being expanded to serve as a resident network. The assessment is comprised of data collected from local residents that have responded to a 20 question survey that focuses on their well-being. While nonprofits have been using this tool to look for trends and create targeted solutions for improvement, there is an opportunity to expand its use
